<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Founders of the Plymouth Colony. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Arrived on the Mayflower. ○ Wanted to break away from the Church of England. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Founders of the Massachusetts Bay Colony. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Created a theocracy. ○ Wanted the Church of England to be less Catholic.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Founded by the Puritans. ○ Eventually included the Plymouth Colony too. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Capital: Boston 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Signed by the Pilgrims when they reached the New World. ○ Stated they should be able to decide to stay in the land they had found: self-government.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Colony originally settled by the Dutch. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Taken over by the Duke of York. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ A self-governing territory. ○ The Puritans formed Massachusetts as a commonwealth.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Founded by William Penn. ○ Created for Quakers, but extended religious freedom to other Christian groups. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Founder of Pennsylvania. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Quaker
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ A government run by religious rules. ○ The political leaders are often also the church leaders. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ A Christian group that broke away from the Church of England. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Emphasize non-violence (pacifism).
