<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ The ability of a person to change their position in society.</li> <li>○ Being able to become more wealthy and powerful, or the opposite.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Wealthy landowners.</li> <li>○ The upper class in colonial society.</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ European intellectual movement in which people began to question the purpose of government and rights of the people.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Very large farms in the South that grew cash crops.</li> <li>○ Relied on slavery in order to make a profit.</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Rights you are born with, and which are not supposed to be taken away.</li> <li>○ Life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ English (European) Enlightenment thinker. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Wrote about natural rights.</li> </ul> </li> <li>○ Said government exists to protect natural rights.</li> <li>○ If a gov't doesn't protect their natural rights, the people can overthrow it.</li> </ul>
